ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

Under the AYUSH Scholarship Scheme, the Government of India provides scholarship for UG and PG courses in Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha, Homeopathy in Indian universities / institutions.

Area of Studies

3-year UG courses:

- ➔ B.Sc., in Yoga
- ➔ B.A. Yoga Shastra

5 and ½ year UG courses:

- ➔ Bachelor in Ayurveda Medicine and Surgery (BAMS)
- ➔ Bachelor in Unani Medicine and Surgery (BUMS)
- ➔ Bachelor in Siddha Medicine and Surgery (BSMS)
- ➔ Bachelor in Homeopathy Medicine and Surgery (BHMS)

Post-Graduate courses

PG courses:

- ➔ Masters in Ayurveda Medicine and Surgery
- ➔ Masters in Unani Medicine and Surgery
- ➔ Masters in Siddha Medicine and Surgery
- ➔ Masters in Homeopathy Medicine and Surgery

PhD courses:

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- ✓ B.A. / B.Sc., in Yoga: schooling equivalent to 12th standard in India
- ✓ BAMS / BUMS / BSMS / BHMS: schooling equivalent to 12th standard in India with compulsory science subjects (Physics, Chemistry, and Biology)
- ✓ MD in Ayurveda / Unani / Siddha / Homeopathy: the relevant BAMS / BUMS / BSMS / BHMS degree recognized by the relevant Central Council in India.
- ✓ PhD in Ayurveda / Unani: the relevant MD degree recognized by the relevant Central Council in India.

The High Commission of India is inviting applications from interested Malaysian nationals who wish to pursue the following courses under the AYUSH Scholarship Scheme 2023-24:

- (ii) Bachelor of Siddha Medicine & Surgery (BSMS) [5 ½ years]
- (iii) Bachelor of Unani Medicine & Surgery (BUMS) [5 ½ years]
- (iv) Bachelor of Homeopathy Medicine & Surgery (BHMS) [5 ½ years]
- (v) Bachelor of Science (BSc) in Yoga
- (vi) Bachelor of Arts (BA) in Yoga Shastra
- (vii) Postgraduate (PG) in Ayurveda
- (viii) Postgraduate (PG) in Siddha
- (ix) Postgraduate (PG) in Unani
- (x) Postgraduate (PG) in Homeopathy
- (xi) Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Ayurveda
- (xii) Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Yoga

2. The application form should be filled online and submitted on the 'A2A Scholarship' portal (<http://a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in>), by **30 June 2023**.

3. Eligibility: For the Bachelor courses, the applicant must have completed any one of the qualifications given below, and should be fluent in English:

- a. STPM
- b. A Levels
- c. International Baccalaureate (IB)
- d. American High School Diploma
- e. 2 years of South Australian Matriculation (SAM)
- f. 2 years of Canadian Pre-University (CPU), or
- g. Any other qualification which is equivalent to 12th standard in India.

4. For the BAMS, BSMS, BUMS, and BHMS courses, the applicant must have taken Physics, Chemistry, and Biology at the qualifying level examination. For the PG/PhD courses, the applicant must have completed the relevant Bachelor/PG courses, respectively.

5. The scholarship provides for Tuition fee, Living Allowance, Contingent Grant, House Rent Allowance, and Airfare. Kindly note that submission of application is not an assurance of admission. The candidates must comply with admission formalities and procedures of the respective college/ university in India.
