



ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING NEW REQUIREMENTS FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF UD41 MEDICAL OFFICERS ON CONTRACT BASIS

In accordance with Malaysian Government Policy regarding the optimization of human resources, and taking into account the current staffing positions as well as updated requirements for hiring/appointing officers by the Public Service Commission of Malaysia (SPA), the Committee for Appointment of Contract Officers convened on the 27th of January 2016 whereupon it was agreed that the following procedures for appointment of contract officers be followed:

- (a) Appointment of new candidates of foreign national for Contract Medical Officer (Houseman) (UD41) posts to be deferred to a future date;
- (b) Permanent Medical Officers (Housemen) (Grade UD41) who have resigned but intend to be reappointed on a contract basis will be considered for appointment based on stricter guidelines, and recommendation for appointment will be made only once. Subsequent appeals for appointment on a contract basis will no longer be considered; and
- (c) Applications for reappointment of Medical Officers (Grade UD41) who have been relieved of their services by the SPA or have been terminated from Public Service will no longer be considered.

In accordance with the above requirement, any decision by the Committee regarding appointments is final, and appeals to the Committee will not be entertained.
