Dr. Lin Ko-Lung graduated from National Yang-Ming University and received his certification from the Taiwan Board of Physical Medicine and rehabilitation. He is currently an Associate Professor of Fooyin University and is attached to the Dept. of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation at Kaohsiung Veterans General Hospital, Taiwan. He has been extensively involved in the research of cardiology, with a recent emphasis towards exercise physiology on cardiac function and has been published in multiple local and international journals.

Dr Tsai Sen Wei graduated from National Yang-Ming University and received his PhD from National Chung Hsin University, Taiwan. He received his fellowship at the Kessler Institute of Rehabilitation and is currently the director of the Department of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Taichung Tzu Chi Hospital in Taiwan. He is heavily involved in research and has been published locally and internationally. His interests include include musculoskeletal ultrasound, spasticity management and cardiopulmonary Rehabilitation.



Dr Ooi Hean graduated from China Medical University, Taiwan (1995), and completed his PhD and Doctor of Philosophy from Taiwan in 2000 and 2015 respectively. He is currently an Assistant Professor in Taiwan and is a Pioneer of medical thoracoscopy/pleuroscopy there His current research work is in the area of lung cancer, pleuroscopy, critical care medicine and chest medicine. He is also a reviewer for many journals' publications.

Dr Saari Mohamad Yatim graduated from Universiti Sains Malaysia and obtained his Masters in Rehabilitation Medicine from University Malaya.
