**SURAT PEKELILING KETUA PENGARAH KESIHATAN BIL.4/2024
SENARAI KATA SINGKATAN (ABBREVIATION) DI FASILITI
KEMENTERIAN KESIHATAN MALAYSIA (KKM)**

1. TUJUAN

Surat pekeliling ini bertujuan untuk memaklumkan penetapan penggunaan senarai kata singkatan di fasiliti Kementerian Kesihatan Malaysia.

Penggunaan kata singkatan di dalam rekod perubatan pesakit adalah tidak digalakkan. Walau bagaimanapun sekiranya perlu, hanya kata singkatan yang diluluskan oleh KKM sahaja boleh digunakan.

2. PENDAHULUAN / LATAR BELAKANG

Kata singkatan dalam terma perubatan sering digunakan dalam dokumentasi rekod perubatan pesakit. Ini disebabkan oleh penggunaan kosa kata diagnosis yang banyak dan panjang dalam dunia perubatan. Penggunaan kata singkatan membantu pegawai perubatan memanfaatkan masa rawatan tanpa meninggalkan elemen penting dalam dokumentasi. Penggunaan kata singkatan memerlukan kesahan bagi memastikan terma yang digunakan tepat dan seragam serta mengelakkan kekeliruan.

3. OBJEKTIF

Memastikan setiap fasiliti di KKM menggunakan kata singkatan yang sama.

Mengelakkan kekeliruan dan salah tafsir anggota kesihatan sekiranya mereka berkhidmat dari satu fasiliti ke fasiliti yang lain.

Membantu pegawai perubatan merekod dokumen dengan lebih efisien dan jimat masa pada setiap tugas dokumentasi.

4. METADOLOGI

Pejabat Penasihat Undang-Undang, KKM tiada halangan berhubung penggunaan kata singkatan seperti yang disenaraikan mengikut ketetapan rekod perubatan pesakit, perkara ini adalah terletak kepada ketetapan polisi KKM memandangkan kata singkatan sedia ada telah digunapakai lebih 15 tahun dan perlu dikemaskini merujuk memo: KKM.600-27/14/38 Jld.5 (17) bertarikh 12 April 2022.

5. TANGGUNGJAWAB

- 5.1. Pengarah Kesihatan Negeri akan bertanggungjawab untuk memantau perlaksanaannya di peringkat negeri.
- 5.2. Pengarah Hospital / Institusi, Pegawai Kesihatan Daerah dan Pegawai Perubatan adalah bertanggungjawab memastikan pelaksanaan penggunaan kata singkatan ini.

6. PELAKSANAAN

Senarai kata singkatan di Fasiliti Kementerian Kesihatan Malaysia ini berkuatkuasa dari tarikh surat ini dikeluarkan. Sehubungan dengan itu senarai kata singkatan yang telah diedarkan pada 21 Mac 2006 adalah terbatal. Dilampirkan juga kod QR untuk pautan senarai kata singkatan sebagai rujukan.

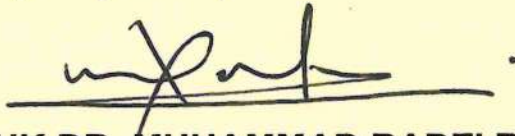

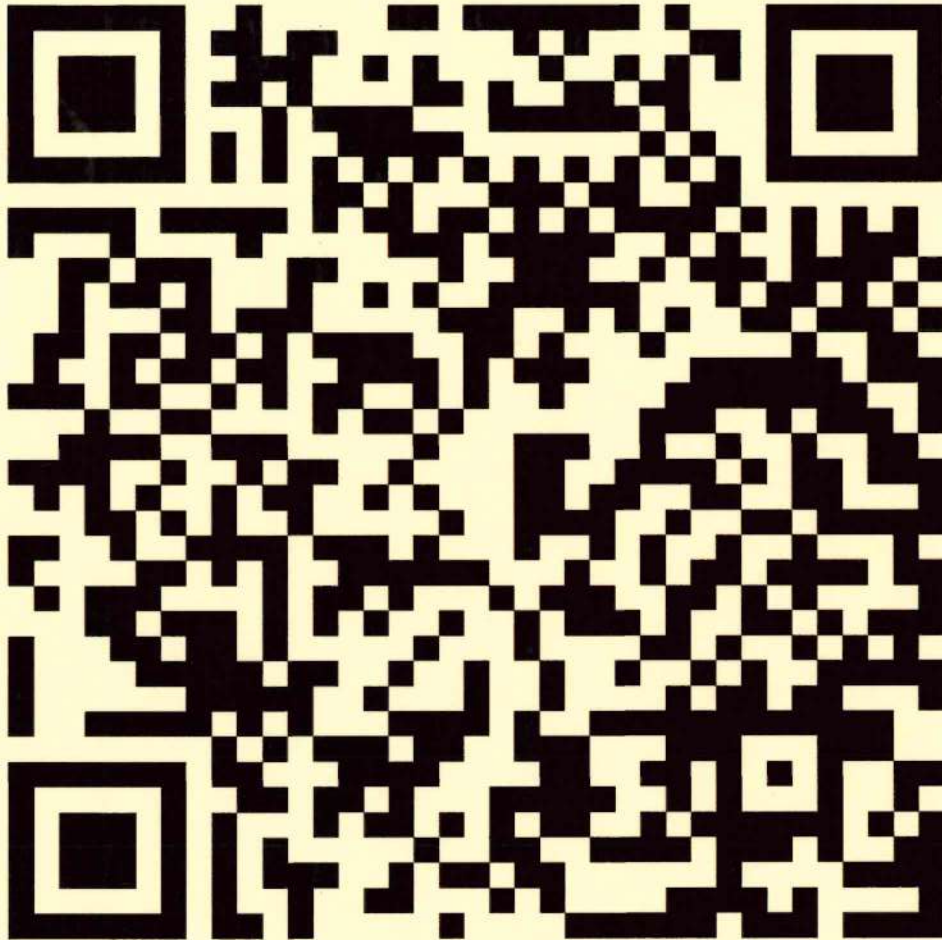
