### MOH BOLDLY PLANNING HEALTH REFORMS IN ALL ASPECT INCLUDING VIA ALLIED HEALTH SCIENTIFIC CONFERENCE 2025

**Bangi, 9<sup>th</sup> September 2025**

The Ministry of Health Malaysia (MOH) is driving **bold reforms to strengthen the nation's healthcare system**, said Minister of Health **YB Datuk Seri Dr. Dzulkefly Ahmad** at the **14th Allied Health Scientific Conference (AHSC) 2025** today.

Delivering his keynote ***“Reimagining Healthcare: A Comprehensive Overview of Health Reform and Its Impact,”*** the Minister stressed that reforms are about **strengthening the public system of health** to ensure **equity, dignity, and sustainability access of it**.

#### **Key Announcements:**

1. **Financing Reform:** New initiatives under **RESET** – including *RakanKKM*, *MHIT*, *DRG*, and the **Dana Kesihatan Nasional (DKN)** – to reduce out-of-pocket costs and secure long-term funding;
2. **Digitalisation:** Faster, smarter care with **Electronic Medical Records (EMR)** and **Cloud-Based Clinic Management Systems (CCMS)**. Waiting times at Klinik Kesihatan are now **cut from hours to just 30 minutes**. Over **20 million Malaysians** already hold vaccination records in **MySejahtera**; and

3. **Workforce Strengthening:** Launch of the **Allied Health Workforce Blueprint 2026–2035**, ensuring allied health professionals remain key drivers of change.

*“This is not privatisation. It is about making our public healthcare system stronger — for every Malaysian, in every corner of the country,”* Dr. Dzulkefly said.

The Minister also **recognised the crucial role of Allied Health professionals**, noting their contributions in prevention, recovery, and innovation.

The conference, themed **“Innovate, Integrate, Inspire: Sustainable Healthcare Through Allied Health,”** brought together **over 500 participants**, 30 exhibitors and sponsors, with strong support from **IHH Healthcare**.

Dr. Dzulkefly officially declared the **14th Allied Health Scientific Conference 2025 open**, marking another milestone in Malaysia’s journey towards a healthier, sustainable future.
