3. Applicants should have **any one** of the following qualifications for applying to the Bachelor courses mentioned above:

- STPM
- A Levels
- International Baccalaureate (IB)
- American High School Diploma
- 2 years of South Australian Matriculation (SAM)
- 2 years of Canadian Pre-University (CPU), or
- Any other qualification which is equivalent to 12<sup>th</sup> standard in India.

4. The applicants should also be fluent in English language and must have taken **Physics, Chemistry, and Biology** at the qualifying level examination.

5. The scholarship provides for Tuition fee, Living Allowance, Contingent Grant, House rent Allowance, and Airfare.
