Authors are kindly requested to adhere to the following guidelines:

A. Format

1. Language: English
2. Abstract text word limit: 250 words (names and affiliation details are excluded)
3. Suggested font: Times New Roman, size 12 cpi
4. Text justification: full
5. Spacing between the title, the author (s) and the abstract text: Single
6. Line spacing of the text: Single
7. Abstract title typed in UPPER CASE
8. Surname (s) of the author (s) typed in lower case preceded by the first name (s) written in full (e.g. Jamilah Omar)
9. Co-authors of an abstract must be no more than 4 (Four) in total.
10. The presenting author's name should be in bold.
11. The affiliation details of all authors [department, institution/hospital, city/town, state (if relevant) and country should be typed under the names, with the corresponding indices, in an order one after the other.
12. The abstract should follow the standard structure below.
